

## MySaskHealthRecord: Spring 2020 Updates

As eHealth Saskatchewan continues to expand on the features and functionalities offered to users of MySaskHealthRecord, the upcoming updates and changes are taking place on April 5, 2020:

- Immunization history will be loaded for all existing users and new users going forward
  - o This data is sourced from the Saskatchewan immunization registry, Panorama
  - o The data loaded will only be immunizations that are available in Panorama
  - o Data will be loaded the week of April 5 and may take a full week before all the data populates MySaskHealthRecord
  
- Ability for existing users to share their MySaskHealthRecord information with other existing users
  - o Users will be able to share parts or all of their record with other MySaskHealthRecord users using a feature called "Share My Record"
  - o Users can provide the option for others to contribute to the user's record by giving read or read/write permissions
  - o Users can suspend or modify access at any time
  
- There will be a 4-day delay on all pathology results moving forward
  - o Through considerable deliberation by providers and health system leaders, a decision was made to implement a 4-day delay to MySaskHealthRecord from the time the pathology results are available electronically to providers
  - o The delay will only apply to pathology results

Given the COVID-19 pandemic, the following changes were made to MySaskHealthRecord in mid-March:

- People registering are able to phone the support line to request their PINs to complete their registration, and the mailing of PIN letters have been temporarily suspended
  
- Access to the COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool link is available in MySaskHealthRecord
  
- COVID-19 test results are available with the following guiding text: *Persons on self-isolation for 14 days because of COVID-19, must remain on self-isolation for the duration of the 14 days despite a negative COVID-19 test result. Please contact your local public health office if you have any questions.*
